## ABOUT THE NEW COLLECTION SYSTEM

### The Cart

The Township purchased and distributed the new carts which are specially constructed to be used in an automated or semi-automated collection system. The cart is designed for ease of handling, durability and has a lid which keeps odors in and moisture out. It is the only container which can be used with the new system.

The cart is being provided by the Township and has a serial number that corresponds to your address. The cart is the property of the Township. If a resident sells their property, the cart will remain at the address originally assigned to the container.

**DO NOT REMOVE FROM RESIDENCE.**

Unless a smaller container was requested, all residents received a 95 gallon cart. The capacity of the 95 gallon cart is more than three times greater than the standard residential can. There is a weight limit for each cart size. The 35 gallon cart can accommodate up to 100 pounds of waste. The 65 gallon cart will accommodate up to 200 pounds of waste. The 95 gallon cart will accommodate up to 300 pounds of waste. A cart filled with standard household waste will not exceed these limits.

**ALL ITEMS MUST BE PLACED INSIDE PROPER CARTS.  
NO ITEMS OUTSIDE CARTS WILL BE COLLECTED.**

### Recycling

Logan Township will now be going to the *Single Stream* method. This means that you will place **ALL** recyclables (plastics, glass, cans, paper, and cardboard) in the **BLUE** 95 gallon cart. Please ensure that cardboard is cut down to fit inside the cart.

### Trash

Please place **regular household waste** in the **BROWN** 95 gallon cart. Please ensure that all regular household waste is properly bagged and inside the trash cart.

### Bulk Metal Pickup

Bulk metal will be picked up on the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of the month. These items include such things as: swing sets, patio furniture, grills, large appliances, bed frames, etc. In order to have bulk metal picked up, please call the Department of Public Works Office at 467-0859 to be added to the Bulk Metal list.

## **Bulk Waste Pickup**

Bulk waste will be picked up on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of the month. These items include such things as: furniture, mattresses, box springs & carpet. In order to have bulk waste picked up, please call the Department of Public Works Office at 467-0859 to be added to the Bulk Waste list.

**\*THE TOWNSHIP WILL NO LONGER BE PICKING UP BULK CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS.\***

## **Construction/ Remodeling/ Demolition Debris**

Residents/ contractors are responsible for the proper disposal of this debris. IT MAY NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE REGULAR HOUSEHOLD DEBRIS CARTS. Any homeowners staging containers/dumpsters on the street or the Township Right of Way, must obtain a permit from the Zoning Office prior to the dumpster's placement.

## **Yard Waste**

Yard waste will **ONLY** be picked up the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month during January, February, March, November & December. During the months, April through October, yard waste will be picked up every Monday. Yard waste consists of grass clippings, brush, leaves, and unpainted/ treated wood. These items should be placed in regular trash cans, old recycling cans (blue or yellow containers) or paper leaf bags. The new trash & recycling carts may also be used.

**\*DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS\***

**CHRISTMAS TREES (ONLY) WILL BE PICKED UP THE WHOLE MONTH OF JANUARY AND MAYBE LEFT WHOLE**

Brush, bushes, unpainted/untreated wood must be cut and tied into bundles no more than four feet in length and not weighing more than fifty pounds. Branches, brush, logs, tree trunks or stumps larger than twelve inches in diameter WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

## **Cart Placement**

Please place trash and recycling carts at least four feet apart from each other and clear of any stationary objects (cars, trees, electrical boxes, mail boxes, etc.) Carts should be placed with arrows facing directly across the street and the wheels against the curb line to ensure proper dumping.
