

## HOW DO I JOIN?

To become part of the team call (856)467-3626 Ext 3019. You may also visit our station any Tuesday night and pick up an application. Upon completion of the application, you must return it to the township Building @ 125 Main Street, Bridgeport N.J. The membership application process will include a confidential background check. After successfully completing a free physical exam, you will be issued your own equipment and a Fire Department ID Card. Applicants must be at least 16 years of age.

## WHAT TRAINING COURSES WILL I RECEIVE?



You will receive Firefighter certification through the Gloucester County Fire Academy. Training courses are available during the evening hours and on weekends. These courses are offered at no charge to LTVFC members. All required equipment and safety gear is provided by the department.

Required training for a firefighter consists of approximately 110 hours of basic firefighting techniques including; fire behavior, rescue, salvage, overhaul, ladder practices, ventilation, firefighting tactics, water supply and more. These classes are usually held two nights during the week, or all day on Saturdays over a four month period.

Fire recruits receive training in the use of the Incident Command System and Hazardous Materials recognition. Additionally, more advanced training is provided at no cost to LTVFC members who wish to further their Fire or Rescue education.
