



# TOWNSHIP OF LOGAN

This letter details the collection of household waste and recyclable materials in Logan Township. It is designed to be significantly more cost effective and provide a cleaner, more attractive community. Please read the attached material thoroughly and feel free to contact the Department of Public Works Office at 467-0859 with any questions.

## ABOUT THE COLLECTION SYSTEM

### The Cart

The Township purchased and distributed the carts which are specially constructed to be used in an automated or semi-automated collection system. The cart is designed for ease of handling, durability and has a lid which keeps odors in and moisture out. It is the only container which can be used for trash collection.

The cart is being provided by the Township and has a serial number that corresponds to your address. The cart is the property of the Township. If a resident sells their property, the cart must remain at the address. **DO NOT REMOVE CARTS FROM RESIDENCE.**

Unless a smaller container was requested, all residents received a 95-gallon cart. The capacity of the 95-gallon cart is more than three times greater than the standard residential can. There is a weight limit for each cart size. The 65-gallon cart will accommodate up to 200 pounds of waste. The 95-gallon cart will accommodate up to 300 pounds of waste. A cart filled with standard household waste will not exceed these limits. You must call the Department of Public Works if you have excess trash or recycling that does not fit in your carts.

### Recycling

Logan Township will now be going to the *Single Stream* method. This means that you will place **ALL** recyclables (plastics, glass, cans, paper, and cardboard) in the **BLUE** 95-gallon cart. Please ensure that cardboard is cut down to fit inside the cart. **Do NOT bag your recyclables.** Recycle carts with plastic bags in them will not be picked up.

### Trash

Please properly bag your **regular household waste** and place in the **GREY** 95-gallon cart.  
**\*\*\*Pet Waste should be properly bagged and placed inside the GREY trash cart\*\*\***



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## **Metal Pickup**

Metal will be picked up on the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of the month. These items include such things as: Swing sets, patio furniture, grills, large appliances and bed frames. In order to have metal picked up, please call the Public Works Office at (856) 467-0859 to be added to the Metal List **no later than noon on Thursday**. Items must be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on the day of pick up.

## **TV & Computer Pickup**

TV's and computer components will be picked up on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month only. In order to have TV's and computers picked up, please call the Public Works Office at (856) 467-0859 to be added to the list **no later than noon on Tuesday**. Items must be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on the day of pick up.

## **Bulk Pickup**

Bulk waste will be picked up on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of the month. These items include such things as: interior furniture, tables, box springs, mattresses & carpet (should be no longer than 4 ft and rolled and secured). In order to have bulk waste picked up, please call the Public Works Office at (856) 467-0859 to be added to the Bulk List **no later than noon on Thursday**. Items must be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. on the day of pick up.

## **Brush Pickup**      **\*\*\* NEW \*\*\***

Effective, January 1, 2024, Logan Township is modifying our yard waste collection and will no longer be picking up tree logs or stumps. Such items must be disposed of privately. Please call into the Logan Township Public Works Department to schedule branch bundle pick up by noon the day prior to pick up. Branch pickup will be on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the Month, March through November. Branches must be smaller than 3-inch diameter and less than 3-feet length, weighing less than 50lbs. Bundles must be tied with twine.

## **Yard Waste Materials**

The below items are acceptable for pickup and must be placed in the yard waste containers provided by the Township. These carts must be properly placed at the curb no later than 6AM on the day of pickup and the lid must be completely closed.

- Grass Clippings • Twigs (less than two inches diameter) • Leaves • Garden Plants • Brush

**\*DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS\***



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CHRISTMAS TREES WILL BE PICKED UP THE FIRST TWO THURSDAYS DURING THE MONTH OF JANUARY AND MAY BE LEFT WHOLE. (REFER TO YARD WASTE SCHEDULE FOR DATES)

**These items will not be picked up and must be disposed of privately.** • Sod • Dirt, mulch • Stones • Broken concrete • Trees • Tree limbs • Logs • Railroad Ties • Stumps • Animal feces and dead animals

## **Construction/ Remodeling/ Demolition Debris**

**\*THE TOWNSHIP WILL NO LONGER BE PICKING UP BULK CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS.\***

Residents/ Contractors are responsible for the proper disposal of this debris. IT MAY NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE REGULAR HOUSEHOLD WASTE CARTS. Any homeowners staging containers/dumpsters on the street or the Township Right of Way, must obtain a permit from the Zoning Office prior to the dumpster's placement. Two trash cans may be put out for pick up for the first Bulk Pickup of the month. Each can should not weigh more than 50 lbs each. You must call the Public Works Office at 467-0859 to be added to the Bulk List **no later than noon on Thursday.**

## **Cart Placement**

Please place trash and recycling carts at least four feet apart from each other and clear of any objects (cars, trees, electrical boxes, mail boxes, etc.) Carts should be placed with arrows facing directly across the street and the wheels against the curb line to ensure proper dumping.
